COW CHIP TOSSING

Which one of your staff members has the best arm? Any football or baseball players among the bunch? Test the strength of their arms and noses by entering them into the cow chip tossing competition. Cow chip tossing makes sure one member of your team endures the glamour of trying to throw a cow chip as far as humanly possible.



BRONC RIDING

Have any wanna be cowpokes around the office? If so, our bronc riding event will allow a member of your staff to showcase their imaginative, comedian self. Bronc riding contestants will be judged on their creativity concerning how well they portray the wild 8-second ride, except they will be riding a child's stick horse.



COW MILKING

Our cow milking event will guarantee laughter and heightened anticipation as two of your staff members do whatever it takes to accumulate the most milk. One person will be designated as the "wild cow" and one person assigned to administer the milking. With the "wild cow" holding rubber glove nipples between his/her legs, it is up to the two person team to devise a successful system of milking.



CHUCK WAGON RACING

Test your staff's ability to work as a team as they race around our track, complete with racing barrels, for the best overall time. With one individual in the wagon, 2 people pulling, and 2 outriders trailing behind, this event will ensure your staff exerts their competitive drive.
